Duty 1

General Summary: Percentage: 40

Painting/Sandblasting

Individual tasks related to the duty:

- Operate compressors, sandblasters, and perform sandblasting to high level bridge steel. This includes rigging and erecting safe work stages and scaffolds at above normal working heights.
- Perform painting of high-level bridge steel with the use of brushes, rollers, airless and conventional spray equipment.

Duty 2

General Summary: Percentage: 40

General Maintenance

Individual tasks related to the duty:

- Perform preparation of work in placing of concrete which includes operation of jackhammer, forming, and finishing of concrete.
- Perform concrete and expansion joint repair, welding, repair to structural members, fabrication of repair items, and cable maintenance.

Duty 3

General Summary: Percentage: 10

Building and ground maintenance

Individual tasks related to the duty:

 Perform and assist in minor carpenter work, painting, plumbing, electric work, general maintenance and other associated minor maintenance tasks on the buildings and other properties of the MBA.

Duty 4

Miscellaneous

Individual tasks related to the duty:

- Maintain upkeep of complete roadway on Mackinac Bridge, plaza area and surrounding properties which includes snow and ice removal.
- Perform traffic control, when necessary, to accomplish required maintenance, including setting up for wind escorting and provide contractors
 access to the bridge.
- Perform security checks as needed which requires the use of travelers, climbing up to the towers and down on the piers.
- Assist in performing escort duties of over width trucks, hazardous materials, high profile vehicles in high winds and assist drivers across the bridge, picking up debris from structure and assisting motorist with minor breakdowns and other general maintenance activities.
- Assist in special events, wind assignments, snowmobile crossing and driver assistance programs.
- Perform other duties as directed or assigned.
