| <p>The Staff Psychiatrist functions as a leader of the interdisciplinary treatment team in the facility Hospital. The leadership is affected through the supervision and direction of the team's professional assessments, diagnosis, treatment planning, treatment, discharge planning, performance improvement and clinical programming activities. The Staff Psychiatrist provides consultation to other psychiatrists on difficult-to-manage patients. This position serves as a member of and carries out the activities of assigned Hospital and Departmental committees. In order to provide continuity of high quality care, the Staff Psychiatrist also share on-call responsibilities.</p> <p>This position requires rotation of an on-call and weekend assignment on a monthly basis.</p> | |

Duty 1

General Summary:

Percentage: 25

Clinical supervision, diagnosis, provision of active treatment, and discharge patients back to the community from an inpatient setting.

On-Call responsibilities

- Management of all special precautions and interventions, including seclusion and restraint.
- Psychiatric treatment as is appropriate to the situation, including, but not limited to, medications and crisis intervention.
- Psychiatric admission assessment and diagnosis with development of an admission plan of service.
- Medical assessment and diagnosis.
- Medical treatment as is appropriate to the situation, including, but not limited to, medications, somatic therapies, and obtaining laboratory specimens.
- Arranging medical consultation for patients who are also in need of specialized care at other hospitals and clinics.
- Consultation with administration on-call as needed.
- Documentation of the activities in the appropriate format.

16. Describe the types of decisions made independently in this position and tell who or what is affected by those decisions.

Independent judgment is used extensively in the medical and psychiatric assessment, diagnosis, treatment, and supervision of treatment of emotionally disturbed patients.

17. Describe the types of decisions that require the supervisor's review.

- a. Complex and/or high risk patients, those who require frequent and/or lengthy limiting interventions, and patients with excessively long lengths of stay, require a supervisor's review.
- b. Decisions as they relate to policy and procedures require a supervisor's review.
- c. Insoluble conflicts within the team as they relate to treatment planning require supervisor's review.

18. What kind of physical effort is used to perform this job? What environmental conditions in this position physically exposed to on the job? Indicate the amount of time and intensity of each activity and condition. Refer to instructions.

A. Physical efforts: The Psychiatrist will spend most of the time sitting, standing, walking, talking, reading and writing; and listening. Reaching for, lifting and carrying medical charts that weigh less than 10 pounds is a frequent activity. Assisting in the physical management of patients in an unusual activity.

B. Conditions/hazards: The Psychiatrist will be exposed to emotionally challenged patients who might need to be physically managed by staff from time to time. While performing medical duties or assisting in physical management, the Psychiatrist might be exposed to a variety of body fluids.

- b. Staff Psychiatrist also provides direct psychiatric and medical services, including assessment and diagnosis, medications, and other therapies.

The Hospital is responsible for the assessment, diagnosis, treatment and discharge planning, and provision of active treatment for emotionally challenged adult patients.

Completion of a psychiatric residency program and one year of experience as a psychiatrist in a mental health, clinic, program, or correctional facility.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

Considerable knowledge of the principles and practices of medicine, surgery, psychiatry and neurology. Considerable knowledge of current theories and practice in the field of mental health. Some knowledge of the organization and operation of a mental health hospital or clinic. The ability to administer a treatment program. The ability to diagnose and treat mental illness, developmental disabilities and related disorders. The ability to communicate clearly and effectively verbally and in writing. The ability to deal effectively with emotionally disturbed individuals, their families and loved ones. The ability to explain, interpret and clarify treatment programs and related issues to staff, patients and relatives. The ability to be flexible and adapt to continuous quality improvement. Knowledge of the age-specific characteristics and treatment issues of assigned population, i.e., young adult (18-39), middle age adult (40-64), older adult (65-80), and geriatric (80+). Knowledge of forensic related issues, security related matters, and channels of communication. Knowledge of and ability to implement CPR and confrontation avoidance techniques. Knowledge of the Mental Health Code. Knowledge of infection control.
