14. General Summary of Function/Purpose of Position

This position is responsible for the management of Materials Management Division (MMD) energy and sustainability related loan programs, including but not limited to the Energy Efficiency Revolving Loan Program and the Small Business Pollution Prevention Loan Program. These programs are established to provide financial incentives to residents, small businesses, and local governments that wish to implement an energy, pollution prevention, or recycling project.

The primary purpose of this position is to expand on existing energy and sustainability financial programs by managing third-party financial programs for the department, developing, and implementing outreach tools to increase access to existing programs, utilizing data and engagement to identify gaps, and by filling gaps and increasing equity by building new or expanded funding opportunities through comprehensive planning, engagement, and implementation.

The individual in this position will be responsible for all aspects of the loan program, establishing policies and procedures, ensuring progress, performing oversight, providing direction in all aspects of the program and reporting on results.

Duty 1

General Summary:

Percentage: 50

Oversee the development and administrative of the energy and pollution prevention loan programs, a complex environmental incentive program that requires working with lending institutions, communities, small businesses, and residents to award low interest loans for energy efficiency, electrification, renewable energy, and pollution prevention. Ensure that the program is deployed and operated in an effective manner to implement program goals and plans, track process, evaluate program results, and prepare special studies. Work with agency staff, the Attorney General's Office, lending institutions, companies, trade associations, environmental interest groups, and other state agencies on continued development, implementation, and evolution of the program to meet goals.

Individual tasks related to the duty:

- Establish program goals, procedures, guidelines and policies.
- Engage stakeholders, such as financial institutions and eligible recipient groups, to inform program offerings and deployment.
- Develop program offerings and materials.
- Evaluate loan application criteria and make decisions on program and project eligibility.
- Provide program guidance to staff that provide support services.
- Monitor and evaluate program budget.
- Gather and analyze necessary data and develop reports and recommendations.
- Monitor and evaluate program results and track progress in accordance with department reporting systems.
- Draft and revise appropriate administrative rules related to the loan program and coordinate division responsibilities under rules procedures.
- Work with staff in EGLE and other state agencies.
- Liaison with trade associations, technical assistance providers, environmental interest groups and other organizations to support program success

Duty 2

General Summary:

Percentage: 35

Oversee and administer revolving loan projects along with fulfilling reporting and monitoring associated with various funding sources per their requirements. Serve as point of contact for the MMD Loans Program, which may include energy efficiency, electrification, renewable energy, pollution prevention, and recycling projects.

Individual tasks related to the duty:

- Day to day oversight of loan projects, tracking progress and providing technical assistance as needed.
- Collect data, prepare and provide reports for monthly, quarterly, and annual required federal and/or State reporting.
- Analyze ongoing program operations and recommend modifications of policies and procedures to meet federal and/or State requirements.
- In coordination with MMD and Administration support, assist in completing and submitting quarterly federal reporting activities for all federally funded programs and analyzing and assessing processes and procedures to identify areas for improvement and growth;
- Perform miscellaneous duties related to the collection and distribution of the monthly, quarterly, and annual reports.

Duty 3

General Summary:

Percentage: 10

Create and implement the MMD Loans Program marketing and outreach strategy. Develop and update communication material, including research, and prepare information for dissemination on the web, in publications, and at related events.

Individual tasks related to the duty:

- Review program metrics of existing financial programs, ensuring program compliance, identifying market gaps that existing or new programs could reach, and summarizing the successes or lessons learned of current programs.
- Develop a plan, recommending modifications to improve overall equitable outreach and program efficacy.
- Collaborating with fellow staff, leverage strategies, contact opportunities, and outreach and engagement activities to develop a plan for presentations, small-group meetings, and activities within MMD, EGLE and other state agencies, to market loan opportunities.
- Directly communicate and engage with consumers, businesses and communities to increase awareness and understanding of funding opportunities while also soliciting input to create equitable funding mechanisms for project development.
- Identify and pursue marketing opportunities. Monitor marketing and outreach activities and evaluate marketing activity progress.

Duty 4

General Summary:

Percentage: 5

- Undertake duties related to sustainability financial programming and outreach as directed by MMD Assistant Division Director or Director.

Considerable independent judgment in performing work and selecting proper course of action. The individual will also conduct evaluation activities and make policy and program recommendations. Decisions made by this position affect Michigan residents, businesses, lending institutions, trade associations, and public interest groups.
